

An inclusive festival for all




Our solution aims to help participants prone to sensory overload by offering them a tool called LotusMap that forecasts potentially overwhelming areas, to help them anticipate stimulating elements, and better manage their sensory experiences at the festival.

Examples of overwhelming stimuli is:

- Navigating overwhelming crowds, such as moving from point A to point B.
 - Dealing with the unpredictability of crowd sizes and locations.

Through the integration of Universal Design principles and active involvement of users in the design process, we aim to make Folkemødet more inclusive with our solution. This approach ensures a better experience for all involved, fostering an environment where everyone can actively engage and participate in the democratic festival.
